RULES & REGULATIONS FORM

Future Latino Leaders Law Camp Participants will:

1. Be a high school student in good academic standing (at the time of application, you must be a freshman, sophomore, or junior) with a minimum grade point average of 2.5.
2. Make a commitment to follow through and participate in all aspects of the Law Camp, including the challenging study and preparation for the Mock Trial and remain in contact after conclusion of Law Camp.
3. Not engage in any other work or occupation during the term of the Law Camp.
4. Comply with rules of conduct and appropriate dress as directed by the Law Camp staff.
5. Be responsible for all costs of transportation to and from the Law Camp site in Washington, D.C.
6. Be responsible for any additional costs incurred by the HNBF as a result of the student violating any of the rules and regulations of the Law Camp, loss of room keys or damage to property, and any additional transportation costs if the student is expelled from the Law Camp.
7. Be supervised at all times by the Law Camp staff. Students shall not be permitted to have any unsupervised time or activities away from the Program.
8. Provide proof of citizenship or permanent residency in order to obtain access to certain government buildings.
9. Discontinue use of cell phones and electronic portable devices except during designated times and locations.
10. Respect and honor the requests of the Law Camp staff at all times.
